Try this activity to demonstrate faith: Ask a child to volunteer. Blindfold them and then place a chair somewhere in the room, and do not let anyone tell the blindfolded child what is going on. Guide them to the chair by backing them up close to it, but do not let them touch it. Then ask them to sit down carefully like they are going to sit in a chair then talk to them about how:

is
NOT BEING ABLE TO SEE
but
TRUSTING THE ONE
WHO CAN



Read “David and Goliath” in a Children’s Bible (or find it in 1 Samuel 17:45-47). Help your child to see that by faith we can do incredible things that bring glory to God.

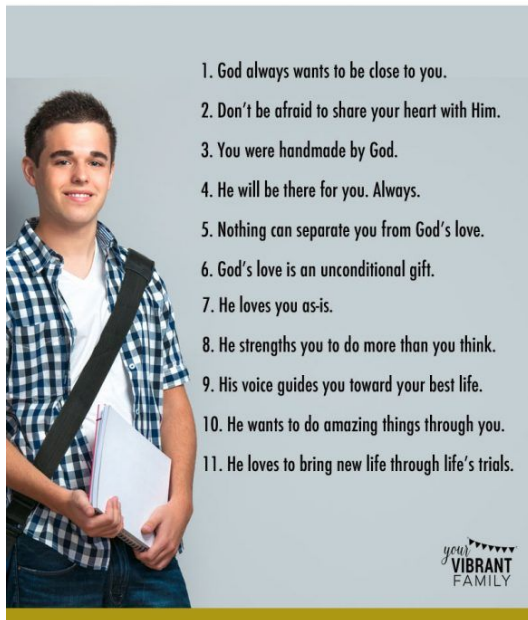
