Cameroon is in the middle of a civil war and it is impacting ChrisWOV. This war is a conflict in the Southern regions of Cameroon between the French speaking and English speaking regions. English The speaking region (which is where ChrisWOV is) has been discriminated[°]against bv the French speaking region. English speaking The region wants to form their own country, Ambazonia. In 2016, English speaking



lawyers and teachers went on strike and protested. Since this time the conflict has grown. There are now rebels fighting against the government. Schools have been shut down for over 3 years and children can't attend school in the English speaking regions. There are kidnappings, killings, and assaults occurring on a daily basis. Dorothy Tanwani, our mission partner contact, has been on lock-down many times as the government tells them not to leave their homes. She has sent me videos of soldiers shooting guns and harassing people in the village. Dorothy has been kidnapped twice and held hostage until a ransom was paid to the rebels. It is such a difficult situation as the ordinary citizen is being harassed by both the rebels and the government soldiers. Over 3,000 people have been killed and half a million people have been displaced from their homes. Just a week ago rebels entered a school that had recently resumed teaching and killed seven school children and injured many others. ChrisWOV is now providing much needed support to these displaced people in addition to the widows and orphans they have supported for years. They are also dealing with COVID just like we are. They are providing training and equipment to help fight the virus. They will be most appreciative of anything you share with them as a Christmas gift as they are providing assistance to so many additional people, due to the Civil War. Thank you for all you do.

This pandemic has affected everyone around the world. Our mission partners in Ecuador, have been affected in unique ways. With FHC, some of the children in their care struggle with compromised immune systems, thus making them more at risk with regards to the virus. In order to limit exposures, caregivers are living on-site and they are not allowing non-essential staff to enter the homes. Ecuador's economy was struggling before the pandemic and they are seeing great need arise in the country. They are ensuring

that they have sufficient resources in place to provide for the various needs of the children. They do not know yet how this will affect financial gifts to FHC, but they are trusting for God's provision.
