and hygiene items so they can use the money they have to get themselves resettled into their old home or into a new home. Heartland Hope is a West Hills mission partner and we are excited to help them as they help our fellow Nebraskans impacted by the flood. Red tubs will be available at both entrances throughout the month of September.

HYGIENE ITEMS: baby diapers, pull-ups, and wipes (critical item needed, sizes 4, 5 and 6)/shampoo and body wash/deodorant/razors/sanitary pads/ toothbrushes and toothpaste/paper items (toilet paper, paper towels, etc..)

FOOD: canned meat/cereal and breakfast food items (breakfast bars, granola bars, pop tarts, oatmeal, etc..)/soup/canned ravioli/anything easy for families to prepare (Microwave dinners, EZ mac, etc..)/baby food and formula/bottled

CLOTHING AND HOUSEHOLD ITEMS: disposable kitchen utensils (spoons, forks, knives, plates)/linens, towels and washcloths/pet food


